

Round 14 Fixtures for Two Day Grades for 21/22 Played Over One Day

In accordance with a ruling of the SMCA Executive, Round 14 (Round 15 in Sixth and Seventh Grade) of 21/22 shall be played over one day with each team receiving 40 overs and 35 for lower two day grades (5, 6 and 7) under two day rules and conditions subject to the following:

75 Over games (1st to 4th)

Games will commence at 1pm with the first session being extended by 15 minutes to 3.15pm to allow for two 135 minutes sessions. The scheduled time for Stumps will be extended by 20 minutes to 5.50pm

Each team will be entitled to 40 overs. At the completion of 40 overs bowled to the team batting first, a 20 minute tea adjournment will be taken. The team batting second will start their innings immediately after the tea break

In the event that the team batting first declares or is dismissed after 2.45pm and prior to receiving 40 overs, the bowling team shall have the option of batting (after 10 minutes changeover) until the tea break at 3.15pm. If the bowling team do not take the option of batting, the tea break of 20 minutes will be taken immediately. The team batting second will then have an additional 40 overs to bat

If the team batting first is dismissed or declares before 2.45pm, the bowling team will bat (after 10 minutes changeover) until the tea break at 3.15pm. The team batting second will then have an additional 40 overs to bat

If the team batting second is dismissed or declares prior to receiving their allotment of 40 Overs (plus overs before tea if applicable), a second innings will commence and proceed to stumps at 5.50pm subject to the requirement of a minimum 17 overs in the last hour or part thereof

65 Over games (5th to 7th)

Games will commence at 1pm with the tea break being taken at 3.00pm to allow for two 120 minutes sessions

Each team will be entitled to 35 overs. At the completion of 35 overs bowled to the team batting first, a 20 minute tea adjournment will be taken. The team batting second will start their innings immediately after the tea break

In the event of the team batting first declares or is dismissed after 2.30 pm and prior to receiving 35 overs, the bowling team shall have the option of batting (after 10 minutes changeover) until the tea break at 3.00pm. If the bowling team do not take the option of batting, the 20 minutes tea break will be taken immediately. The team batting second will then have an additional 35 overs to bat

If the team batting first is dismissed or declares before 2.30pm, the bowling team will bat (after 10 minutes) until the tea break. The team batting second will then have an additional 35 overs to bat

If the team batting second is dismissed or declares prior to receiving their allotment of 35 Overs (plus overs before tea if applicable), the second innings will commence and proceed to stumps at 5.20pm subject to the requirement of a minimum 17 overs in the last hour or part thereof
